

Floyd County Board of Supervisors Meeting  
March 29, 2023, 9:00 a.m.

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors met at Floyd County Courthouse EOC/Training Room with the following in attendance: Supv Mark Kuhn, Supv Dennis Keifer and Supv Jim Jorgensen.

Keifer/Jorgensen moved to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public comment: none.

Kuhn/Keifer moved to approve Res #13-23\* County Attorney Full-Time to Part-Time Position: Effective March 12 Rachel Ginbey, County Attorney, resigned from her full-time county attorney position causing a vacancy in the elected office of Floyd County Attorney; per Iowa Code 69.14 the Board lawfully published notice of intent to fill the vacancy of by appointment; the Board has considered applicants to fill the vacancy, one being a candidate to serve as a part-time county attorney while maintaining a private practice; per Iowa Code 331.752, it is the Board's desire and believe it to be in the best interest of the residents and taxpayers of Floyd County to change the status of the full-time county attorney position to a part-time county attorney position; the salary for the full-time county attorney would require an appropriate adjustment in salary for the part-time county attorney position; be it resolved by the Board to make it effective March 29, 2023 to change the status of the Floyd County Attorney position from a full-time position to a part-time position per Iowa Code 331.752; be it further resolved that the Board deems it appropriate to consider the salary of the full-time county attorney previously approved at \$114,005 for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be adjusted to \$84,000 for the remainder of this fiscal year and for FY24 and remain effective until changed as provided in Iowa Code 331.907 for FY25; be it further resolved that the Board hereby appoints Todd Prichard as a part-time Floyd County Attorney effective March 29 and to serve until a successor is elected to the position. Roll call vote: Ayes-Kuhn, Keifer, Jorgensen. Motion carried 3-0.

Jorgensen/Keifer moved to approve Todd Prichard as the part-time county attorney to fill a vacancy. Motion carried 3-0.

Jorgensen/Keifer moved to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
