September 19, 2023, 10:30 a.m.

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors/Canvassers met for Canvass of the September 12, 2023 Central Springs Community School District Special Election at Floyd County Courthouse Board Room with the following in attendance: Supv Mark Kuhn and Supv Jim Jorgensen; Absent: Supv Dennis Keifer

Supv Kuhn announced the canvass.

Jorgensen/Kuhn approved the agenda. Motion carried 2-0.

Auditor Carr presented canvass materials including election night reports, precinct tally books, and abstracts for review.

Jorgensen/Kuhn moved to approve Res #36-23* Certification of Floyd County Election Results: The Central Springs Community School District Special Election was held as prescribed by law on September 12, 2023; the Board canvassed the vote of said elections in accordance with Iowa Code 50.24. Be it resolved that the Board hereby certifies the voter turnout and the Tier 1 Canvass for the Special Election held September 12 and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass. Turnout: 226 voters. Votes of the district in Floyd County: Yes = 113, No = 113. Be it further resolved that the Floyd County Auditor/Commissioner of Elections shall maintain the Official Canvass and Abstracts for the September 12, 2023 Special Election. Roll call vote: Ayes-Jorgensen/Kuhn. Motion carried 2-0.

Kuhn/Jorgensen moved to adjourn. Motion carried 2-0.
