Ordinance #2022-2 Local Option Sales and Services Tax

Whereas, on April 4, 2022 the Floyd County Board of Supervisors presented Ordinance #2022-2 Local Option Sales and Services Tax Ordinance and filed with the county auditor copies of the same;

Whereas, notices were timely given of ballot propositions for the imposition of a 1% Local Option Sales and Services Tax for the jurisdictions of the City of Charles City and the unincorporated area of Floyd County with a Special Election held on March 1, 2022 which declared the public measure favorably passing for both jurisdictions;

Whereas, after voters have approved a local option tax, the board of supervisors must adopt an ordinance imposing the tax;





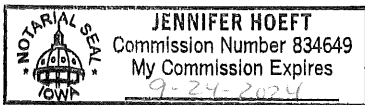

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-2

Local Option Sales and Services Tax Ordinance

An ordinance establishing a Local Option Sales and Services Tax applicable to transactions within the incorporated area of Charles City, of Floyd County, and all Unincorporated area of Floyd County

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Floyd County, Iowa:

Section 1. Local Option Sales and Services Tax. There is imposed a local option sales and services tax applicable to transactions within the city of Charles City, and in all unincorporated area of Floyd County.

The rate of the tax shall be one percent (1%) upon the gross receipts taxed under Iowa Code Chapter 423, Division IV and 423B – Local Option Tax, in the following: the city of Charles City, and in all unincorporated area of Floyd County.

The local sales and services tax is imposed on transactions occurring on or after January 1, 2023 until December 31, 2032 for the City of Charles City, and in all Unincorporated area of Floyd County.

All persons required to collect State gross receipts taxes shall collect the tax pursuant to Iowa Code Section 423B.8 for local option sales and services tax.

All applicable provisions of the appropriate sections of Chapter 423V, Division IV, of the Iowa Code are adopted by reference.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provisions or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
