RESOLUTION DECLARING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
TO BE AN ESSENTIAL SERVICE

A resolution by the Floyd County Board of Supervisors (Floyd County) to declare emergency medical services (EMS) to be an essential county service as authorized by Iowa Code Section 422D.1.

WHEREAS, Floyd County contracts for EMS for its residents.

WHEREAS, ensuring efficient and effective EMS coverage is essential for maintaining the health and welfare of its residents.

WHEREAS, in order to be able to efficiently and effectively provide EMS to its residents, the Board of Supervisors will proceed with the process under Iowa Code Section 422D.1 to declare emergency medical services as an essential county service in order to allow a local option income surtax and/or an ad valorem property tax for EMS and the creation of a county emergency medical services system advisory council to assist in researching and assessing the service needs of the county and guiding implementation of the same.

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2023, Floyd County directed that notice of the first meeting to consider this resolution be made and any other actions be taken as necessary to proceed with the process under Iowa Code Section 422D.1 to declare EMS to be an essential county service.

First Reading: July 10, 2023 Approved Denied

Second Reading: July 17, 2023 Approved Denied

Third Reading: July 24, 2023 Approved Denied

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Floyd County hereby declares emergency medical services to be an essential county service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Floyd County directs that and any other actions be taken as necessary to proceed with the process under Iowa Code Section 422D.1 to declare EMS be an essential county service.

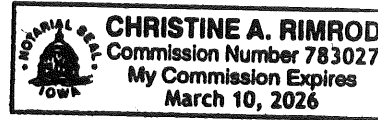

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION
TO DECLARE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AS AN ESSENTIAL SERVICE IN FLOYD COUNTY, IOWA**

The Board of Supervisors of Floyd County, Iowa will meet on July 10, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. at the Floyd County Court-house to consider taking action on a resolution to declare emergency medical services (EMS) to be an essential service for Floyd County with a potential second reading and final reading at our next two meetings as authorized by Iowa Code Section 422D.1.

The proposed resolution will allow for an election to be offered for voter approval of an ad valorem property tax not to exceed seventy-five cents per thousand dollars of assessed value or an income surtax of up to one percent on the state individual income tax of each individual residing in Floyd County at the individual's applicable tax year, or a combination of these. Dollars collected by either of these shall be used for EMS. A county emergency medical services advisory council shall be created to assist in researching and assessing the service needs of the county and guide implementation of the same under Iowa Code Section 422D.1.
